

Maths

- 12 o'clock?
- 5 o'clock?
- 8 o'clock?

Watch the Numberblocks episode 'Flatland'. What shape names do you know? Can you talk about how many corners, straight sides and curved sides?

Have a go at playing the 'Shape Patterns' game – can you challenge yourself to try level 2?
