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| <b>Monday – At 10am do your free Phonics lesson</b><br>FS ZOOM Chat FSK 11.30am,FSR 1.00pm,FSAS 1.30pm |  |
| <b>Task 1</b>  | Listen to Mrs Roberts read the story “The Very Hungry Caterpillar”.  |
| <b>Task 2</b>  | Make a list of all the things the caterpillar ate from Monday to Friday. Remember, use your phonics when you are chopping up the words and make sure you read your writing back to make sure it makes sense. |
| <b>Task 3</b>  | Make a moving caterpillar. You will need some paper, scissors and a straw. Use the YouTube video to help you.  |

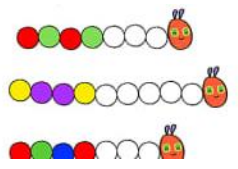
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| <b>Tuesday – At 10am do your free Phonics lesson</b> |   |
| <b>Task 1</b>  | Watch the video of a butterfly hatching from its chrysalis. Talk to your grown up about what you saw happening. Is it like how it happens in the story? |
| <b>Task 2</b>  | Look at the outdoor picture and have a go at reading the labels.  |
| <b>Task 3</b>  | Make a paper chain caterpillar. If you don't have red and green paper or card, use whatever you have and then colour it in or paint it.                 |



**Wednesday – At 10am do your free Phonics lesson**

**Task 1** Draw a butterfly life cycle (use the worksheet to help you).

**Task 2** Can you draw and colour a caterpillar using two colours? Now have a go using three colours. Have you made a repeated pattern? If you have any sequins, beads, or pom poms you could make a patterned caterpillar with those.



**Task 3** Have a go at making your own slime. You will need some hand wash, water and baking soda. Follow the YouTube video. Have fun making it and then play with it again two days later!

**Thursday – At 10am do your free Phonics lesson**

**Task 1** Watch Numberblocks episode “Seventeen”. Talk to your grown up about what happened in this episode.

**Task 2** Practise your maths by playing the Numberblocks “Number Magic Adding and Subtracting game”.

**Task 3** Make a butterfly collage picture using leaves, petals or sticks from your garden.



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| <b>Friday – At 10am do your free Phonics lesson</b> |   |
| <b>Task 1</b>                                       | Watch the Numberblocks episode “Eighteen”. How many different ways did the Numberblock make itself into 18? Eg. 9 groups of 2. Can you count in 2’s?  |
| <b>Task 2</b>                                       | Complete the “Subtraction Number Stories” worksheet.  |
| <b>Task 3</b>                                       | We want you to role-play the story of “The Very Hungry Caterpillar”. Make yourself into a little egg curled up on a leaf. Then pop out as a wiggly caterpillar – what are you going to munch on today? Now you need to make yourself into a chrysalis and when you’re ready to wriggle out you will be a beautiful butterfly! Can you find any material to make some wings. Grown-ups we would love to see your children role-playing! If you video them or take some pictures please send them to us using the FS email. |
