


## Foundation Stage “At home” work

<b>Monday</b>	
<b>Task 1</b>	Watch the ‘Dinosaur Invasion’ video clip. The Dinosaur has invaded our classroom. We must tell it all about the fun we have in our classrooms.
<b>Task 2</b>	Write a letter to the dinosaur about the activities we do in our classroom. Use the ideas sheet to help you.
<b>Task 3</b>	Go to the garden - find some leaves, sticks and petals. If you have glue then stick them on a piece of paper or card to make a picture. If not lay them on the floor and see how many different pictures you can make before tidying them away.

<b>Tuesday</b>	
<b>Task 1</b>	Watch the story “Dear Dinosaur” – use the link.
<b>Task 2</b>	If you met a T-Rex, what would you ask it? In your jotter write down the question you would ask. You can use some of the ideas from the story to help you.
<b>Task 3</b>	Watch “How to draw a dinosaur” and then have a go at drawing your own dinosaur in your jotter. 

<b>Wednesday</b>	
<b>Task 1</b>	Did you notice that near the end of the “Dear Dinosaur” story one of the letters looked different? It was an email. Watch the story again to see if you can spot it? Can you ask your grown to help you send us an email or a picture? Tell us what you have been busy doing and send it to <a href="mailto:foundation@dale.derby.sch.uk">foundation@dale.derby.sch.uk</a>

<b>Task 2</b>	Read the 'oa' story and make a list in your jotter of all the 'oa' words you spot in this story.
<b>Task 3</b>	Practise saying some of the dinosaur names with a grown up. Use the 'Dinosaur Names' worksheet to help you. Which one is your favourite and why?

<b>Thursday</b>	
<b>Task 1</b>	Watch the NumberBlocks episode "Ten Green Bottles". Talk to your grown up about what you have learnt.
<b>Task 2</b>	Practise your subtraction – play the Top Marks game 'Building Expressions' – grown-ups please follow the 'How to set up Building Expressions' worksheet to set up the game ready for your child to play.
<b>Task 3</b>	Quiz Time - Read the questions with an adult and answer "yes or no". Have a go at writing the answers in your jotter.

<b>Friday</b>	
<b>Task 1</b>	Watch the NumberBlocks episode "Number 13". Talk to your grown up about what you have learnt.
<b>Task 2</b>	Ask a grown up if you can have the box of your favourite cereal. Count out 5 pieces of cereal. Eat 1. How many are left? Now count out 7 and eat 1. How many are left? Repeat with other numbers up to 10. Challenge yourself to write a number sentence e.g. $5 - 1 = 4$ .
<b>Task 3</b>	Watch the Cosmic Yoga episode "Tiny the T-Rex" and join in with all the moves. <div data-bbox="1098 1659 1465 1865" data-label="Image"> </div>
