

BBC bitesize KS1')</p> <p>Watch the information about the different seasons.</p> <p>This week we are learning about the different signs of spring.</p>	<p>Tadpoles During spring, frogs lay eggs in ponds called frogspawn. Label your drawings.</p> 	<p>Count to 100 Count on your own or with this video to help you. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=rkxjAa3755U (Or search on YouTube for 'Welcome to the zoo Jack Hartmann')</p> <p>Challenge: Can you count backwards from 100 to 0?</p>
<p>Tuesday</p>	<p>Daffodils</p> <p>During spring lots of flowers start to grow. A flower you might see is the daffodil.</p> <p>Draw a daffodil.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you name the different parts of the daffodil?</p> 	<p>Daffodils grow from bulbs. Watch this video about bulbs. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=op86kAE0Ns_w (or search on YouTube for 'come outside bulbs')</p> <p>There is a story about Billy who picked 10 daffodils in the video. Did you notice that some of the words rhyme? Write down as many words that rhyme with these words:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">hat dot play</p> <p>E.g. hat, cat, splat...</p>	<p>If Miss Smith plants 10 daffodil bulbs and Mrs Singh plants 8 bulbs how many daffodils will they grow in all?</p> <p>You could draw the daffodils to help you answer the question.</p>  <p>Challenge: If Miss Roome plants 7 more bulbs, how many daffodils will the teachers have altogether?</p>

<p>Wednesday</p>	<p>Chicks Another sign of spring is chicks hatching from their egg. Hens lay eggs.</p>  <p>Watch this video about eggs. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=s_wQujfPhXd0 (Or search on YouTube for 'come outside eggs') Can you spot any chicks?</p>	<p>Chicken Licken Watch this story about Chicken Licken. You could read along with the story. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=GGCbOjz8v_iY (or search on YouTube for 'chicken licken from oxford reading tree')</p> <p>Answer these questions: Why did Chicken Licken think that the sun had fell on him? What animals are in this story?</p> <p>Challenge: Draw and cut out the characters and tree from the story. Use them to re-tell the story.</p>	<p>Miss Smith went to the shop and bought 24 eggs but on the way home she dropped 8 of them! How many eggs does Miss Smith have left?</p>  <p>Challenge: Miss Roome had lots of eggs so she gave Miss Smith 10 more. How many does Miss Smith have now?</p>
<p>Thursday</p>	<p>Lambs Lambs are baby sheep. Lambs are born in the springtime.</p>  <p>Wool is a material that we get from sheep. Watch this video about wool. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=41jx0Ljy23A (or search google for 'come outside a woolly jumper') Challenge: What other materials can you think of? (plastic, metal) Go on a material hunt around your home.</p>	<p>Russell the Sheep Watch the story Russell the Sheep. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=zTm_zjn1sdc (or search on YouTube 'Russell the Sheep High Prosody')</p> <p>Russell decides to count things to help him to relax and fall asleep. Think about things that help us to relax. What can we do to relax when we feel angry or upset?</p> <p>Challenge: Russel wears a stripy bed hat. Could you design a new bed hat for Russell?</p> 	<p>Helicopter Rescue https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/helicopter-rescue (or search in google 'Topmarks helicopter rescue')</p> <p>Play find a number to 100 on helicopter rescue.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write the numbers from 0 to 100? You could make your own 100 square.</p>

The Very Hungry Caterpillar

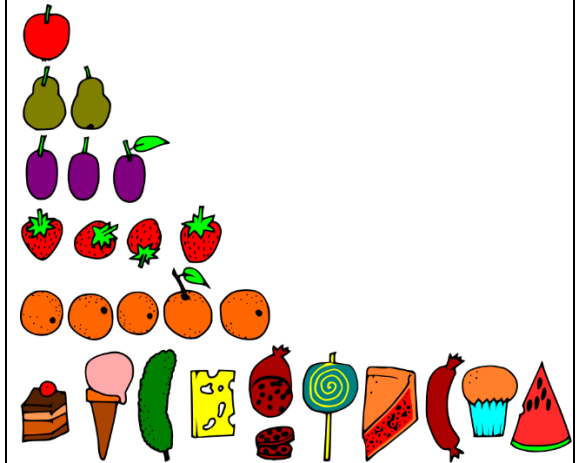
